



## **Lifeguard**

Seasonal, Evenings and Weekends

Reporting to the Head of Aquatics and the Program manager, we are currently seeking experienced or entry level lifeguards who are interested in working evening and weekends throughout the summer. This position will assist in implementing all water safety policies and procedures and supervising members and guests in and around the aquatic facilities.

### **Primary Responsibilities**

- Supervises and observes swimmers at all times to ensure their safety
- Enforces rules of conduct at the pool.
- Administers care to swimmers' and members injuries.
- Performs required pool pre-opening duties.
- Maintains a courteous, polite and helpful relationship with all members and guests.
- Vacuums pool bottom; empties automatic skimmer; skims bugs and other debris from surface to prepare pool for daily use.
- Assists in maintaining the cleanliness of changing rooms, bathrooms and showers.
- Informs supervisor on duty of unresolved member or guest disruptions that could cause a safety problem.
- Maintains all necessary records determined by the Head, Aquatics.
- Attends all meetings as directed by the Head, Aquatics.

- WSI Certification (asset but not required)
- Lifesaving Instructor Advanced Level Instructor and Examiner (asset not required)
- Current CPR/First Aid/AED/Oxygen Administrator
