



## **Lifeguard/Instructors, Aquatics**

Seasonal, Full - time

Reporting to the Head of Aquatics and the Program manager, we are currently seeking experienced seasonal full-time and part-time Lifeguards/Instructors who will be ambassadors of the Waegwoltic Club. This position will assist in implementing all water safety policies and procedures, supervising members and guests in and around the aquatic facilities, as well as conducting water safety classes in a safe and responsible manner.

### **Primary Responsibilities**

- Supervises and observes swimmers at all times to ensure their safety
- Enforces rules of conduct at the pool.
- Administers care to swimmers' and members injuries.
- Performs required pool pre-opening duties.
- Employs only those methods and teaching techniques outlined and approved by the Red Cross.
- Serves as a lifeguard when instructed by the swimming pool manager.
- Maintains a courteous, polite and helpful relationship with all members and guests.
- Vacuums pool bottom; empties automatic skimmer; skims bugs and other debris from surface to prepare pool for daily use.
- Assists in maintaining the cleanliness of changing rooms, bathrooms and showers.
- Informs supervisor on duty of unresolved member or guest disruptions that could cause a safety problem.
- Maintains all necessary records determined by the Head, Aquatics.
- Attends all meetings as directed by the Head, Aquatics.

- 2+ years experience
- Current CPR/First Aid/AED/Oxygen Administrator
